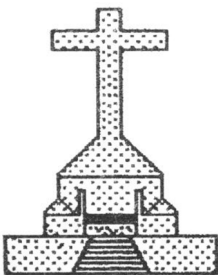

Dear Brother's and Sister's of Medjugorje North East and beyond, as we reflect on Our Lady's message for Christmas Day let us remember that she is the woman clothed with the sun, who stands on the moon, with a crown of twelve stars on her head. She is the one who fights the enemy, and all that threatens humanity with destruction.

So often Our Lady has told us that she needs our prayers for the Triumph of her Immaculate Heart. So Our Lady begins the message with the threefold call to prayer “**Pray, Pray, Pray.**” Let us note what Our Lady does not say, she doesn't ask us to ‘talk, or study or discuss.’ Important and necessary as these are she underscores the vital importance of prayer. Emphasising the very word ‘**Pray**’ three times Mary really wants us to make prayer our priority above everything else.

Once Sr. Briega McKenna was overwhelmed by the duties she had to perform, and in the midst of all her

activity she heard the voice of the Lord speaking, “This time is for me, Said Jesus to her. Sr. Briega often uses this little story to illustrate that if we are too busy to pray, then we are too busy!

Our Lady asks us to ‘Pray, Pray, Pray.’ At the heart of Our Lady's plea, and it is a real imploring with this threefold call to prayer are plans of peace and Joy. This is the reason for Mary's coming in Medjugorje, to show the world the way to peace.

‘Peace must reign between God and Man.’ Were her very first words on 24th June, 1981.

All of her messages during this time have been about the path of renewal and hope and Resurrection. The message of peace brought to us by the queen of Peace, doesn't consist only of ways to stop wars, but also to stop any destruction of human life. Mary calls humanity to a deeper understanding of life from its very beginning, , protection of nature and creation, deep peace between God and Man, and between all people.

The word ‘Pray’ is repeated three times in this month’s message, but we shouldn’t become too analytic about this, but simply do as Our Lady requests and that is to pray more. So let us look at what Our Lady has asked us to do concerning prayer;

1. Who is supposed to pray? Every person. Every nation, every parish, every family, and every prayer group.
2. What should we pray? Right from the start of the apparitions Our Lady taught us to pray the Apostles Creed, the Lord’s Prayer, the Hail Mary, Holy Mass and Holy Scripture.
3. How are we to pray? Our Lady taught us how to pray with the heart. i.e. with Faith, trust and love in God’s mercy and tenderness.
4. For what should we pray.? Firstly for our Lady’s intentions, especially the Triumph of her Immaculate Heart. Then we should pray for the gift of the Holy Spirit, and the Gift of Faith, and in this month’s message that ‘Peace reign and prevail in every heart.

This is the simple format of prayer that Our Lady has shown us over the years, the important thing is to decide for prayer in the midst of our own lives.

As we begin this New Year, a Holy Year of Jubilee, let us each take to heart the threefold call to Prayer and begin by looking into our own hearts and create the conditions for peace to

reign there. Our Lady asks that our own inner peace may prevail over peacelessness.

So let us begin personally and become channels of God’s peace, with Our Lady, Queen of Peace, that the Peace of Christ may ‘Prevail’ in our world.

A Happy Holy Year to you all.

**December 25, 2024
Our Lady’s Annual Message
to Jakov**



At the last daily apparition to Jakov Colo on September 12th, 1998, Our Lady told him that henceforth he would have one apparition a year, every December 25th, on Christmas Day. This is also how it was this year.

The apparition began at 2:45 pm and lasted 8 minutes. Our Lady came with little Jesus in her arms. Through Jakov, Our Lady gave the following message:

"Today, on this day of grace, in a special way I am calling you not to live a life striving for earthly goals and not to seek peace and joy in earthly things, because in this way darkness takes over your life and you do not see the meaning of your life. Little children, open the doors of your hearts to Jesus, permit Him to take over your entire life so that you may begin to live in God's love and mercy. My children, only with Jesus in your hearts will you come to know the true goal of your life and long for eternal salvation. I am blessing you with my motherly blessing."

Dear friends, praise be to Jesus and Mary!

2. The Angels of Bethlehem. As Christmas approaches, our hearts yearn to fully experience the graces that Heaven offers us on this wonderful day when the Savior of the World is born, and which Mary calls *The Day of Joy*. Among the best distributors of joy, let's think of the multitude of Angels who sang of the glory of God above the little shepherds tending their flocks in the fields of Bethlehem. Why don't we invoke the help of the Angels, when we need joy so badly?



Here is one of my most vivid memories. I was invited to give a talk on Medjugorje to 2000 people at a European city. When I arrived, I saw that their faces were serious and sad. I was afraid of being put off right from the start, and I said to myself: "If they don't laugh at my little funny stories, it's going to be very dry". Then I had the idea of calling the Angels of Bethlehem to my rescue, because they matched my needs in every way: their numbers, their joy and the fact

that they were bearers of good news. I said to them: "You see my embarrassment, so please fill this entire place and stand by each person. Remove any heaviness! Let the joy overflow, let the atmosphere be light, cheerful, and let the message go straight to their hearts!"



Angels and Baby Jesus

So I went for it... I was surprised to see a sudden cheerfulness lighting up everyone's faces! How encouraging! But I was even more surprised when they started laughing without me saying anything particularly funny. A few minutes later, their laughter increased so much, the joy burst out with such intensity that I was forced to slip a secret word to my troop of angels:

"Dear angels, OK, you have sown incredible joy, thank you! But, if they keep laughing like that, how will I be able to keep talking? Could you turn the volume down a little bit, please, so I can still deliver the message to them?"

It was a memorable evening, as the Angels once again dazzled me with their power and concern. What a wonderful key Heaven has given us here! If you're feeling burdened, call

on the Angels of Bethlehem! They sweep away all sadness and do so with a delightful sense of humor; don't leave them jobless, live *the Day of Joy* to the full! (PS1)

3. Will Mary empty Purgatory? In the early 80s, Our Lady revealed that on Christmas day, she goes to Purgatory to free many souls and open the Gates of Heaven for them. It is during that *Day of Joy* that she frees the most souls, even more than on All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day (PS2). Let's take advantage of this providential grace to entrust many souls to her!

But be careful! Let us entrust to her those we love and who loved us, and also those who may have hurt us while they were alive! **This *post-mortem* forgiveness** may be difficult in the moment, but it will bring floods of mercy to us and to those persons, because on the other side of this life, evil has no place: only divine love prevails.



Purgatory

4. Fabio has come a long way! For 14 years, this young man was involved in drug trafficking, crime and prostitution, not to mention other addictions.

We were in Sao Paulo, Brazil, and our friend Father Enrico was celebrating holy mass outdoors in a favela located in one of the city's most dangerous suburbs. **As Fabio walked by**, he heard words he had never heard before. That was Father Enrico, full of the Spirit of the Lord, who forcefully declared this before this gang:

“I don't know what your current situation is, but I do know that **the Lord is knocking on the door of your heart!** If you open it to Him, He will come in and sit at the table with you; He is inviting you to rest on His Heart in order to heal your wounds!”

That day Fabio decided to open his heart to Jesus... A few months later, as Christmas approached, he wrote a beautiful letter to the Infant Jesus. Today, *in this time of grace and expectation*, I would like to share with you these lines from a heart that has escaped the hellish spheres of this world, to help you sing with us the extraordinary goodness of our Savior:



From Fabio, the ex-murderer, to the Infant Jesus:

“Thank you, Jesus, for I have been born again. I don't celebrate your birthday superficially, but with a great

joy that comes from the depths of my heart, in a very different way! Not drunk on wine, but on the oil of your anointing. Not snorting cocaine, but breathing in the pleasant fragrance of your Presence. Not armed with a gun, but with the sword of truth, your Word which is Spirit and Life. Not stealing, but giving love to my neighbor. Not killing, but winning souls for God. Not locked up in a brothel, but enjoying the true joy that only you, Jesus, can give my heart. Not locked up in prison, but enveloped in your infinite Love...

That is why I want to live this day as if it were the last day of my life.

On this special day of your birthday, Infant Jesus, the only gift I can bring you is happiness, the happiness of your Presence! Thank you, Jesus! **You were born for me so that one day I could be reborn in You!"**

Today, Fabio is married and the father of a beautiful little girl, and he is evangelizing together with Father Enrico at the Alliance de la Miséricorde (*Mercy Alliance*)!



Dearest Gospa, dear little Mama pregnant with Jesus, you who carry within you the most beautiful of all human children, we have a message for Him that I ask you to please pass on to Him: *“O Jesus, the heavenly Father placed you in Mary's womb so that she could give Him to the world. So, in these days of joy, come quickly into our poor hearts thirsting for love! Didn't you come to earth for sinners, the poor, the sick, the hopeless, the lost?”*

MIRJANA AND FATHER PETAR

Medjugorje Secrets

(Gino Pitaro—Medjugorje News FB)

There has been some controversy, or if you will, relative bewilderment, over Mirjana's words that have almost cast doubt on whether she herself is the person destined to be the conduit of the Secrets to be revealed to humanity, that is, the bridge between them and the priest chosen to reveal them from time to time. The moment of the unveiling to humanity before the events occur will take place as everyone knows through the medium of a representative

of the clergy chosen by her, who has always been identified as Father Petar Ljubičić, and only ten days before he will know the moment and will not be able to exempt himself from this task. His eyes will only be able to read the Secret to be communicated, three days before it manifests itself. It is important to emphasize as proof of the veracity of the Marian manifestation itself, that Our Lady does not use a deterministic approach, so she educated the visionaries to a certain kind of mental attitude devoid of improper leaps forward. The Queen of Peace therefore told Mirjana to choose a priest for the revelation of the Secrets, and she, perhaps with an inner locution or out of purely free choice and conscience, decided on this priest who was educated but also very close to the lives of the poor and needy. Father Petar himself has repeatedly said that he felt a certain strength and energy when Mirjana communicated this will to him, but the Marian pedagogy of



these decades is clear, which is why Mirjana said 'if I will be the intermediary of the secrets the priest chosen by me will be Father Petar.' It is in the logic of things that it will be Mirjana, but Our Lady teaches us not to follow these human paths, but to surrender ourselves to God's will by annulling that ego that puts us in a state of acquired authority, of premature investiture, since the authority is only that of the Father, the Son and She who

is Mediatrix of all Graces, Mother and Advocate of ours, pointing us to Christ. This is a very clear aspect in the visionaries and one that should lead to some reflection even for those who do not believe in Medjugorje, that is, how absent in the visionaries is that protagonism over their own fellow missionaries, sometimes quite natural, that leads to wanting to be the bearer, spokesperson, leader of a group. The behavior of the visionaries really seems to be afferent to an authority external to the group itself and to the clergy, which is that of God and His maternal face, namely the Mother of the Living. This was an aspect that did not go unnoticed by unprejudiced skeptics, the more so because of the heterogeneity of their lives and personalities that could easily derail them toward certain non-harmonious protagonisms among them. Our Lady therefore gives us directions, suggestions, educates us in prayer and shows us the Way, but she did not grant earthly imprimaturs,

precisely because the maternal task is not substantiated in this but in a repositioning of the dispositions of the heart and intellect. After giving Mirjana the task of choosing a priest, Our Lady did not add anything else in this regard. It is simply in the dynamic in being not to disquisition further, precisely because Our Lady invites us to see a different Beyond, to change our horizon of deep consciousness to produce those important, positive and inevitable changes. Mirjana also is not the only one who knows the ten secrets, but there are also Ivanka and Jakov, and presumably shortly or even during the unfolding of them, Marija, Ivan and Vicka as well. Each of them will have a role, either in communication or in mutual support. For example, Vicka will presumably continue to have daily appearances during the time of the Secrets; Ivanka will be supportive of the community of local faithful and parishes, as will Jakov; Marija will have a focus on those in Italy and around the world; and Ivan will have a privileged role with the Americas. Some of these are just my considered assumptions.

It has also been ventilated by Mirjana that the Secrets during their gradual clearance may be announced by the Pope himself or by a major ecclesiastical authority. It is not excluded, especially when the international community will become aware after the first three, that what is claimed in Medjugorje is authentic, without forgetting that the center of everything is God's Mercy.

Our faith is based on a single event: the Incarnation. Our faith is based on a Person: Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of God.

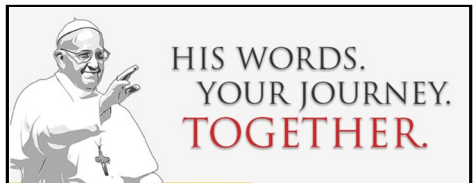

Medjugorje Parish Priest Fr. Zvonimir Pavičić:

Let our New Year's resolutions be the Rosary, fasting, Holy Bible, confession and the Holy Eucharist

(04.01.2025)



Away from the noise of the world, many welcomed the new year 2025 by coming to pray in Medjugorje.

The prayer program in the Church of St. James began with the Rosary at 5 p.m., a thanksgiving Holy Mass was celebrated at 6 p.m., and after that, a live nativity scene was staged once again in front of the church. The prayer vigil began with the adoration of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament at 10 p.m., and the peak was the Holy Mass, which was concelebrated with numerous bishops and priests, in the presence of several thousand pilgrims, and was presided over by the parish priest of Medjugorje, Br. Zvonimir Pavičić.

Some of the countries from which pilgrims arrived in Medjugorje to contemplate once again, as Br. Zvonimir said, the mystery of the incarnation in the silent night of Bethlehem included: Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Poland, Italy, Germany, Austria, Ukraine, Slovakia,

the Czech Republic, France, Spain, the USA, China, Korea and Singapore...

Fr. Zvonimir Pavičić said at the beginning of his homily that with today's feast we end the Christmas octave and that the Church does not celebrate the New Year in the way the world celebrates it.

"For us, we have Mary, the Mother of God at the beginning of the year, the feast that closes the narrower circle of the celebration of the birth of Christ. These eight days we have celebrated the birth of our Lord in the flesh of the Virgin Mary, and today we are called to reflect on Mary's motherhood," said Fr. Zvonimir, explaining what it means that Mary is the Mother of God?

"She conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit. She did not conceive by human power, by human seed, but was overshadowed by the Power from above, from heaven. "Therefore the child to be born will be holy - the Son of God." This is how the angel Gabriel explained it to her when she herself stood before this mystery. Mary did not understand everything immediately, but she believed in the word of God. She believed completely and so she became the one who leads in faith. The Church Fathers say that Mary gave birth to God first in her heart, believing the

angel's words, and then she conceived and gave birth to Him in the flesh. Thus she was first a disciple of God, and then the Mother of God," said Fr. Zvonimir, and he placed before us Mary the Mother of God as a guide to faith, because: "She shows us by her example that we should always trust the Lord, no matter if sometimes His path seem difficult and impossible to us."

He said that in today's Gospel passage we hear again about the events in Bethlehem when the shepherds found the newborn baby, Mary and Joseph. Mary reflected on all these events, as the evangelist Luke says: "Mary kept all these events in herself and pondered them in her heart."



"Mary is no ordinary woman. She is a model for all women. She is blessed among women. Mary is no ordinary disciple. She is a model for all Christ's disciples. As a model, she encourages us to store these events of salvation in our hearts and to ponder them, for faith is born in the heart and faith requires reflection - that pondering in the heart - so that the heart may completely submit to the will of God and accept it in everything," said Fr. Zvonimir, explaining what that pondering in the

heart means and how we can imitate the Blessed Virgin Mary in this today.

"Mary gave birth to Christ - the Word became flesh. We have this Word written in the Gospels. It is therefore necessary to take the Holy Scriptures in our hands, especially the Gospels, read them, reflect on them, and sift through these words and events in our hearts. In this way, we too will be able to observe the newborn Jesus in the manger in our hearts, with the eyes of faith, and follow his growth, preaching, and work of redemption. Mary is a very quiet person in the Gospels, we barely have a few sentences of her, but she is a person who prays, contemplates, and accepts God's will in silence," said the parish priest of Medjugorje, Fr. Zvonimir Pavičić.

He concluded his homily with an invitation that "our New Year's resolutions should be:

the Rosary,
fasting,
the Holy Bible,
confession,
and the Holy Eucharist."
